At 6:05 P.M. Mayor McDonald called the meeting to order.

Agenda item 2 was the Pledge of Allegiance.

Agenda item 3 was roll call. Those present were Council Members Cohrs, Fisher, Sporrer and Mayor McDonald.

Agenda item 4 was to approve the agenda. Motion was made by Sporrer and seconded by Fisher to approve the agenda. 3 ayes.

Agenda item 5 was to open the Public Hearing to hear comments for or against amending the FY 2016/2017 city budget. There were no comments from the public.

Agenda item 6 was to adjourn the Public Hearing. Motion was made by Cohrs and seconded by Sporrer to adjourn the Public Hearing. 3 ayes.

Agenda item 7 was to open the regular city council meeting.

Chief Christensen discussed different uses for Piko, such as narcotic detection, tracking and evidence recovery. Motion was made by Cohrs and seconded by Fisher to approve purchasing the K-9 dog from the City of Denison in the amount of \$5,000 if the funds can be raised, but if they cannot be raised it will be returned to the City of Denison by January 16, 2017. 3 ayes.
