At 6:00 P.M. Mayor McDonald called the meeting to order.

Agenda item 2 was the Pledge of Allegiance.

Agenda item 3 was roll call. Those present were Council Members Cohrs, Fisher, Sporrer, Moss and Czarnecki and Mayor McDonald.

Agenda item 4 was to approve the agenda. Motion was made by Cohrs and seconded by Czarnecki to approve the agenda. 5 ayes.
