SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
CITY HALL, 108 W. 4TH STREET
July 16, 2013

At 7:00 P.M. Mayor Pro-Tem Foutch called the meeting to order.

Agenda item 2 was the Pledge of Allegiance.

Agenda item 3 was roll call. Those present were Council Members Crum, Johnson, Clark and Lefeber and Mayor Pro-Tem Foutch.

Agenda item 4 was to approve the agenda. Motion was made by Mayor Pro-Tem Foutch and seconded by Crum to approve the agenda with the addition of citizen's questions and comments after agenda item number six. Lefeber, Crum and Mayor Pro-Tem Foutch voted aye, Clark and Johnson voted nay. The motion was approved.

Agenda item 5 was to discuss and consider advertising for the Police Department opening. Discussion was held about the job description and advertising for the position.

Agenda item 6 was to discuss and consider a motion to instruct the city attorney to file Declaratory Judgment Action and a Writ of Mandamus against Mike Foutch. The following motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Clark. 1. On behalf of the City Council of Logan, the City Attorney shall file a Declaratory Judgment Action against Mike Foutch, Mayor Pro-Tem, confirming: a. The Mayor Pro-Tem's interference with City officials and/or employees carrying out their official duties. 2. On behalf of the City Council of Logan, the City Attorney shall file for a Writ of Mandamus against Mike Foutch, Mayor Pro-Tem to: a. Allow/grant Vicki Schroder possession of the City Administrator's/City Clerk's files, computer and office as well as all other files and information necessary to carry out her duties; b. Temporarily and permanently prohibit Mayor Pro-Tem from interference with Vicki Schroder as City Administrator/City Clerk in all her duties. Lefeber, Clark and Johnson voted aye, Crum voted nay and Mayor Pro-Tem Foutch abstained. The motion was approved.

Agenda item 7 was citizen's questions/comments: Terry Francis, Jim Ettleman, Pam Oviatt and John Espenmiller all spoke of the actions of the City Council.

Motion was made by Crum and seconded by Johnson to adjourn. 5 ayes.
