Miscellaneous Information

Basic services in the community include a post office, two banks, grocery store, drug store, medical clinic, nursing home, a bakery, a café and restaurant, hardware & electronics store, one gas station and a service station. The Harrison County Courthouse is located in Logan and a complete list of department phone numbers can be found in the Logan section of the phone book under the words “County or Harrison”. The population of Logan at the last census was 1,545.

Logan is located approximately 30-40 minutes away from Council Bluffs or Omaha.

Building permits are required before any new construction or alterations or additions can take place. Applications and information sheets are available at City Hall.

Pet licenses are required for all cats and dogs. Prices are \$5 if spayed/neutered and \$10 if not. Proof of rabies vaccinations is required. The license is to be renewed every January.

The city’s snow emergency ordinance states that vehicles cannot be parked on any city street, alley or city parking during a snow emergency or when the snow plows are operating. Snow plows may be out anytime there is more than 2 inches of snowfall. All vehicles parked in violation of the ordinance will receive a \$25 parking ticket and/or be towed so that the city crew can effectively plow the city streets.
